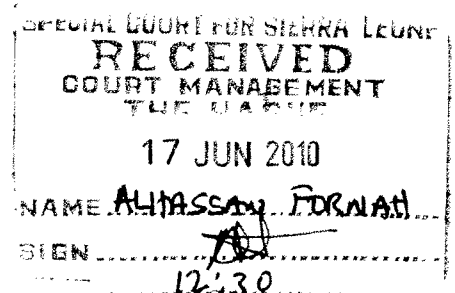


DEFENCE APPLICATION TO CORRECT THE TRANSCRIPT OF 14 JUNE 2010

1. The Defence files this application for the Trial Chamber to order an amendment of the transcript of 14 June 2010 pursuant to Rule 81(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Special Court for Sierra Leone (“the Rules”).
2. The Defence notes that there might be a transcription or translation error on the part where the Witness DCT-285 was asked to read out the dates written on a document put in front of the Witness. This error appears on page 42587, line 23, where the Witness is recorded as saying “14 August” instead of “13 August”.
3. The Court Reporters have confirmed that, after listening to the audio tape of the proceedings of 14 June 2010, there is a transcription error and the Witness did actually say “13 August” (“thirteen of August”) and not “14 August” (“fourteen of August”) as transcribed in the final transcript.
4. The Defence therefore respectfully requests the Trial Chamber to order an amendment to the transcript of 14 June 2010 by replacing the number “14” (“fourteen”) on page 42587, line 23, with the number “13” (“thirteen”) in order to correctly represent the evidence that was given by the Witness at that time.
