#### PALM OIL RULES

made by the Governor in Council under section 12.

Citation.

1. These rules may be cited as the Palm Oil Rules.

Interpreta-

- 2. In these rules—
- "right" means an exclusive right to construct and work mills to be operated by mechanical power for expressing or extracting oil from the pericarp of palm fruits.
- "area" means the extent of land over which a right as defined in this rule is applied for or granted, as the case may be.

Form of areas.

3. Subject to such exceptions as the Governor may approve every area shall be in the form of a circle.

Form of application.

4. An application for a grant of a right shall be made in writing in the Form A in the schedule hereto. Such application shall set forth the name in full, address, and occupation of the applicant, and if he be not resident in the Colony or Protectorate the name and address of an attorney resident in the Colony or Protectorate duly appointed to represent the applicant in all matters concerning the application and the grant, the period for which such right is applied for, the area, the names of all paramount chiefs known to the applicant or his attorney owning or exercising jurisdiction over any land within such area.

Particulars concerning applicant.

5. The applicant shall supply such further information and particulars as the Governor may require concerning the applicant, and as to his financial position and general bona fides.

Survey of area.

6. The Governor may, in any case in which he shall deem it necessary, require before a right is granted in respect of any area, that the same be demarcated or surveyed by such surveyor as he shall approve.

The cost of such demarcation, survey or fixing shall be paid by the applicant, and he shall desposit with the Accountant General such sum as the Governor may direct as security for such payment.

7. The Minister shall, if he considers the information supplied Commisunder sections four and five hereof to have been satisfactory, sioner to be send a copy of the application to the District Commissioner informed. of the district in which an area or any portion thereof is situate.

8. The District Commissioner shall cause a meeting of each Consultation with Tribal Tribal Authority exercising jurisdiction over such area or any Authority. portion thereof to be summoned and shall cause the application to be read over and explained at such meeting.

9. If the Tribal Authority consent to the grant of the right, Form of consent by they shall express such consent in writing which shall be in the Tribal Form B in the schedule hereto and shall be read over and Authority. explained by the District Commissioner to the members consenting to the grant who shall sign such consent in his presence.

10. The grantee shall erect and maintain a concrete pillar not Publication of notice less than six feet high and two feet thick, at the centre or at on area. such point as the Governor may in writing direct, of his area, on which shall at all times be posted a notice in the Form C in the schedule hereto, stating the name of the grantee and a description of his area.

11. Any grantee resident in the Colony or Protectorate, or if Penalty for he be not so resident, then his attorney, who fails to comply publication. with the requirements of the last preceding section shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable, on conviction before a Magistrate, to a fine not exceeding five pounds for every day on which the offence is committed or continued.

12. A grant of a right shall be under the hand of the Governor and the Public Seal of the Colony, and may set forth any terms and conditions prescribed by the Governor under section three of the Palm Oil Ordinance. Such grant shall be in the Form D Cap. 230. in the schedule hereto or as near thereto as circumstances permit.
