DEFENCE REQUEST FOR A STATUS CONFERENCE PURSUANT TO RULE 65BIS

1. The Defence respectfully requests the Trial Chamber to convene a Status Conference pursuant to Rule 65bis of the Special Court Rules of Procedure and Evidence, as soon as practicable following the conclusion of the judicial recess on 7 January 2011.<sup>1</sup>

### 2. Rule 65bis states:

A status conference may be convened by the Designated Judge, the Trial Chamber or a Judge designated from among its members. The status conference shall:

- (i) organize exchanges between the parties so as to ensure expeditious trial proceedings;
- (ii) review the status of his case and to allow the accused to raise issues in relation thereto.
- 3. The Defence would like to review the status of the case, given that there are a number of outstanding filings before the Trial Chamber and the Appeals Chamber and yet the parties are scheduled to file their final trial briefs on 14 January 2011.<sup>2</sup>
